Solicitation shall be Monday through Friday only, between the hours of 9AM and 5PM. No solicitations on Saturdays, Sundays or Legal Holidays. Solicitation upon municipal streets shall require the written approval of the Chief of Police and other applicable requirements shall apply prior to approval. AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 771 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF BYESVILLE, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Byesville has enacted Chapter 771 of the Codified Ordinances regulating peddlers and solicitors; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Byesville desires to amend said Chapter.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Byesville, County of Guernsey, State of Ohio:

Section I: Section 771.01 is amended to read as follows:

PERMIT REQUIRED. Every person wanting to engage in the business of traveling with in the Village, soliciting orders for or selling goods, wares, merchandise or other articles for profit, and every person wanting to engage in the solicitation of funds for any charitable, religious, educational or other purpose, is required first to apply for and obtain a permit to engage in such activity from the Village Clerk. The permit shall be for a stated length of time and shall require the advance payment of the fees set forth under Section 771.02.

Section 771.02 is amended to read as follows:

FEES; DURATION. The permits required by §771.01 shall be for the periods of time and require the advance payment of the fees as follows:

(a) For any length of time up to, and including, ten days: twenty-five dollars (\$25.00);

(b) For any length of time in excess of ten days, but not in excess of thirty days: seventy-five dollars (\$75.00).

No permit shall be issued for any period of time in excess of thirty days from the effective date of the permit. If an applicant desires to continue in an activity herein regulated for a period of time longer than thirty days, he must reapply for a new permit and pay the fee required for it by this Section, upon the expiration of the time for which the initial permit was issued.

(c) No fee shall be charged for a permit issued to a civic and/or non-profit group.

A permit issued to a civic and/or non-profit group shall be effective for a period of time not to exceed one year from the effective date of the permit.

Section 771.03 is amended to read as follows:

HOURS. Solicitations by civic and/or non-profit organizations shall be conducted from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Sunday.

All other peddlers and solicitors shall be permitted to conduct activities within the Village during week days from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

All persons conducting solicitations upon municipal streets, state routes or other roads located within the corporate limits of the Village shall wear a safety vest of either reflective or non-reflective material. The vest will be supplied by the group or individual

conducting the solicitation. All persons soliciting donations must wear identification identifying the person or organization when soliciting.

Section 771.99 is amended to read as follows:

PENALTY. Whoever violates any provision of this Chapter shall be fine twenty-five dollars (\$25.00). Each day during which a violation continues shall constitute a separate and distinct offense. In addition, the solicitation permit of a person or group violating this Section may be revoked at any time for behavior deemed inappropriate including, but not limited to, fraud, misrepresentation, inappropriate sales activities, intoxication, or other similar violation.

Section II: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Byesville, Ohio, and in particular, to amend Chapter 771 of the codified Ordinances of the Village of Byesville, Ohio.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
